Benton House Visitation Policy

- Benton House is proud to return to normal operations and welcome guests back to our community. Visiting hours are between 7am and 9pm daily, and there are no restrictions on length, frequency, or number of visitors.
- Visitors enter the community at the main entrance and sign-in and out of the community at the reception desk. Hand sanitizer is available at the sign-in desk and masks and other Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) are available at all times, upon request.
- The community's visitation policy and infection control and education policies are located at the reception desk and included at the end of this policy. Verbal instructions about this information may be obtained from the Executive Director or designated Person in Charge (PIC).
- In the event of a confirmed communicable disease in the community, we will notify guests as part of screening.
- In addition to notification, we may ask that guests visit in the resident's apartments and/or wear appropriate PPE specific to the infection control practices as guided by the local Department of Health.
- Visitors will not be asked or compelled to provide proof of vaccination or immunization status.
- Consensual physical contact between a visitor and resident is permitted.
- The Executive Director is responsible for staff adherence to the visitation policy. In the absence of the Executive Director, the Person in Charge / Manager on Duty will be responsible for staff adherence to the visitation policy.
